FAQ'S

WHAT IS THE TRANSPORTATION?

We are using Western, a family-ran charter bus company with one of the best safety records of any charter bus company. Each 56 passenger bus is equipped with a restroom, AC, high definition flat screen tv's, wifi, and power outlets for charging devices. The travel time will be around 2 hours one way.

WHAT IF MY KID HAS MEDICATIONS?

We have a 3 Registered Nurses along with a team of support staff ready to assist any first aid or medication needs. There is a designated MEDS station adjacent to the Cafeteria. PLEASE encourage your students to be faithful on their medication timelines so we don't need to track them down.

WHAT IS THE PROTOCOL FOR SAFETY?

First, there is a tight schedule that keeps kids constantly moving. We have strict security when students are given freedom in their schedule during the 3 hour free time slot Saturday afternoon. Maps are provided which indicate the camp boundaries and students are to enjoy those activities in groups.

WHAT IS THE RATIO OF ADULT LEADERS?

State Law mandates a 12:1 ratio. Most camps recommend 10:1. Mission City takes a 5:1 ratio. Each adult leader has passed a mandatory background check as well as completed the Ministry Safe sexual abuse training modules and Mission City's Leadership Development class.

ARE THERE THEME NIGHTS THIS YEAR?

We're so glad you asked! Yes there are. Have fun with the following themes:

Friday Night: "Leader Hunt"—Wear black!

Saturday Night: "Disco Night"—Wear 70's Gear (Bright & Shiny)

WHAT'S THE FOOD LIKE?

Three full meals a day prepared by a full team of chefs. Unlimited refills on drinks and each meal includes dessert options. Additionally, there is a gift shop available to purchase snacks and souvenirs during the Free Time slots. Your dietary needs and/or food allergies have been sent to Highland Lakes.
